The house serves and takes care of the basic needs of local, underprivileged children, including food, clothing, shelter and an education that encompasses language skills, applied sciences, music, art and craft, cooking and social studies.

Harmony House's key objectives are to provide a safe, fun, educational and loving environment for children and women living in the nearby slums. With many of its children attending school only for a few hours in the morning or not at all, Harmony House allows the children to break away from the harsh climate of their usual surroundings and spend their free time in enjoyable, stimulating and nurturing surroundings.
